### THE ARTISTS

Todd Yaniw, recently awarded his doctorate in piano performance from the University of Texas was highly acclaimed as a performing artist well before completing his studies. Only 13 when he debuted with the Edmonton Symphony Todd remains in demand as a concerto soloist with Canada's major orchestras, including the Toronto Symphony. He has toured in Canada, Europe, Britain, the USA, China, and Jamaica, recorded under the Chestnut Hall, and been the repeated guest of the CBC. His command of the instrument is astounding, his musical expression sublime, his interpretation at once passionate, intelligent and provocative.

Toddy Yaniw has recently come on board with QSCM as resident pianist. This means he will be available for collaborative work with soloists we bring to perform at St. Paul's as well as undertaking outreach initiatives under the sponsorship of QSCM. Todd is that rare combination of a highly gifted musical nature married to the discipline of academic training, making him an extremely valuable member of any ensemble team as well as a profound player in his own right.



Sebastian Sallans is an award winning violinist well known in the Quinte area. He grew up here, spending his weekends driving to Ottawa for violin lessons. Upon graduating from Centre Hastings Secondary in Madoç, he entered the University of Toronto as a scholarship student. Since earning his Bachelor of Music in Violin Performance, Sebastian performs as a soloist and professional orchestral violinist with orchestras in the GTA, and across Ontario and Quebec. He has appeared as guest associate concert master with the North Bay Symphony and as a soloist in numerous recitals and concerts.

A versatile musician and in demand as a studio violinist in the Indy film business, Sebastian was recently featured on a Ryan Driver's latest album and plays frequently with other non-traditional, pop, jazz and fiddle groups. Sebastian is committed to encouraging new composers and frequently performs new music on the cutting edge of the contemporary composition scene. Intent on continuing to develop as a professional concert artist, Sebastian has studied in Toronto, Quebec, and Europe and plans to pursue further training the USA.
